
TOLO-P30 (3KW) Stainless Steel Sauna Heater Manual



Please Read The Manual Carefully Before Installation

All electrical wiring to be installed by a qualified licensed electrician in accordance with National Electrical Code and local electrical code.

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1. Introduction

Thank you for choosing TOLO-P30 sauna heater with well-designed structure, steady performance



and convenient installation. Sauna-bathing kit is mainly composed of the heater and sauna room. After Sauna-bathing, people feel the flow of the spirits, excrete virus in body, eliminate fatigue, release the muscle and also good for health.

TOLO-P30 sauna heater is designed for small sauna room. (Ref to table 1).

2. Safety Warning

- It's forbidden to use the sauna heater for any other purposes.
- ◆ The heater gets extremely hot during operation and should not be touched otherwise burns may result.
- Children should be adequately supervised.
- ◆ Elderly persons, pregnant women, as well as those people who are suffering from heart disease, high blood pressure, diabetes or people not in good health, please seek medical opinions before using the sauna room.
- This appliance is not intended for use by person (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Do not smoke in the sauna room.
- ◆ Do not use the sauna room when under the influence of alcohol.
- Do not use the sauna room immediately after strenuous exercise.
- Leave the sauna room at once if you feel sleepy, sick or uncomfortable.
- Ensure there is good ventilation for the sauna room.
- ♦ When you go out, or may not use sauna heater in long time, please DISCONNECT the general power supply to sauna heater.

Commercial operators should post a notice of these precautions in a prominent position near sauna room.

Notes: Above room volume is subject to sauna room with heat preservation.



4. Installation

- 4.1. Installation of sauna heater
- The location of the heater should fulfil the minimum requirements concerning the distances given in table 1 and figure 2.
- Do not install the sauna heater on the floor or in a cabinet.

- Screw the sauna heater to the wall. (see figure 2A&2B)
- Install a guardrail for safety. (see figure 2C&2D)
- The sauna heater is installed at least 180mm above the floor. (See figure 2D)

 Directly plug in the power and switch on the sauna heater, users can take a sauna bath.







4.2. Circuit diagram



5. Functions And Operation

Ensure there is nothing near the heater before switching on it. The heater and the stones may emit smells when you use the heater for the first time, make sure that the sauna room has been efficiently ventilated or open the sauna room door.

The temperature that bather preferred to is about $60^{\circ}90^{\circ}$ C. Too powerful heater will heat sauna room too quickly while the temperature of stones may remain insufficient. Consequently, the water thrown on the stones will run through but will not produce sufficient vapor. On the other hand, if the heater is under-powered, the heating time will be much longer.

Attentions:

- Do not hang clothes to dry in the heater, for this may cause a risk of fire.
- Do not bake food in heater .
- Keep away from the heater when it is hot, the outer surface of the heater may burn your skin.
- Never put cover on the heater.
- Do not use heater without stone.
- Do not put wood on the heater.
- Do not use chlorinated water.

5.1. Set time

Built in model

Time setting range: 0-60 minutes, can not be continuous working.

The timer is the main power switch in heater.

The timer automatically cut off the power if it exceeds the setting time.

ATTENTION: Check sauna room before restart the timer.

5.2. Set temperature

Built in model

Temperature setting range: $30-110^{\circ}$ C.

When setting time is achieved, heating elements will stop working, and the whole sauna heater are under status of heat preservation, when room temperature is lower than setting, heating elements will start working again automatically.

5.3. Resetting the Overheat Protector




Figure 4 Reset button for over-heat protector





Figure 5: (PILING OF THE SAUNA STONE)

If the temperature of the sauna room becomes dangerously high , the overheat protector will permanently cut off the supply of the heater. The overheating protector (**Figure 4**) can be reset after the heater has cooled down. Please check that the stones are piled properly(**Figure 5**) and ensure proper air circulation in the room with inlet and outlet vents (**Figure 6**).

Attention: If the overheat protector cuts off the power supply, please do not reset it immediately as it may damage the normal operation and lifespan of the over-heat protector.

6. Sauna Stone Arrangement

Cautions:

- Do not use the heater without stones, otherwise it may cause a fire.
- Only use the original sauna stone, or the stone for use in heater.
- Do not use ordinary stone, that may emit harmful substance, easily break and do not possess good heating capacity.
- Wash the stones to clear the dust before putting them into the heater. The diameter of stone is about 3-8 cm. Stones of unspecified sizes should not be used.
- Put the larger stones at the bottom of stove compartment and the smaller ones on the top, do not pile them tightly so that air can flow freely.
- The stones should not be placed too tightly or too loosely. The stones should averagely cover the heater element. (See figure 5).
- Rearrange the stones in the heater at least once a year or twice if it is in frequent use (maximum 500 hours). To decide the correct volume of stones in the heater, refer to technical data provided in table 1.

7. Sauna Room Ventilation



- 1. Air supply vent.
- 2. Optional air supply vent if mechanical exhaust ventilation is used, the opening is located 50cm above the heater.
- 3. Exhaust air vent.
- 4. Drying vent, which is closed during heating and bathing. Sauna room also dried by leaving the door open after bathing.

If there is only an exhaust vent in washing room, leave a MIN 5cm opening under the sauna room door. (Mechanical ventilation is recommended).

- To ventilate the sauna room, the way is to draw air around the heater and move the heat to the farthest part of sauna room.
- Considering air ventilation of sauna room, the inlet vent and the outlet vent should be installed.
- The inlet vent may be installed on the wall below the heater (figure 8A). When using the mechanical ventilation, inlet vent is placed at least 50cm above the heater (figure 8B) or on the ceiling above the heater (figure 8c). The heavy cold air that is blown into sauna room is mixed with the light hot air from the heater, bringing fresh air for the bathers. The inlet vent should have a diameter of 5-10 cm.
- The outlet vent should be placed diagonally opposite to the inlet. It is advised the outlet vent is placed under the platform in a sauna room as far as possible from the inlet vent. It can be installed near the floor, or lead outside through a pipe from the floor going to a vent to the sauna ceiling, or under the door (to the washroom). In this case, the sill slot must be at least 5cm and it is recommended there is mechanical ventilation is the Wash Room. The size of the outlet should be twice of the inlet.

8. Sauna Room Insulation

The door, ceiling and walls of sauna room are necessary to be insulated in order to preserve heat.

To prevent spreading moisture to other rooms or wall structure, make sure that moisture-roof is appropriate in sauna room. Moisture-proof must be placed between panel and heating insulation. Moisture and thermal proofing should be installed from outside to inside, such as:

- Recommend that the MIN thickness of the thermal insulation in the walls is 50mm and in the ceiling is 100mm.
- Aluminum foil laminate is affixed over the heating insulation as a vapor barrier.
- Leave at least 20mm air slot between vapor barrier and inside panel.
- Leave a slot between wall panel and ceiling to prevent gathering moisture behind the panel.

9. Warranty And Services

Notes: Warranty period will count from the ex-factory date of sauna heater.

- i. Limited warranty is offered to all customers. Any quality problem will be covered according to above file. Please provide the maintenance record when you ask for warranty.
- ii. Our company has the right to decide whether to repair or to change. Approval must be obtained from our company before shipping back the product. The customer has to pay for the transportation fee and any parts fee beforehand.
- iii. Any clause mentioned in the manual is not covered by the warranty.
- iv. This warranty does not cover any defect, malfunction or failure cased by, or resulting from unauthorized installation, maintenance and repair, improper power supply, and any action which violates the manual.
- v. Damage caused by accident, misusing of chemistry products, or any other reason which are beyond our company's responsibilities will not be covered. Any product whose label, nameplate has been removed, altered, damaged is not covered either.
- vi. After the free warranty period, services are still available if all cost is covered by the customer.
